STEP

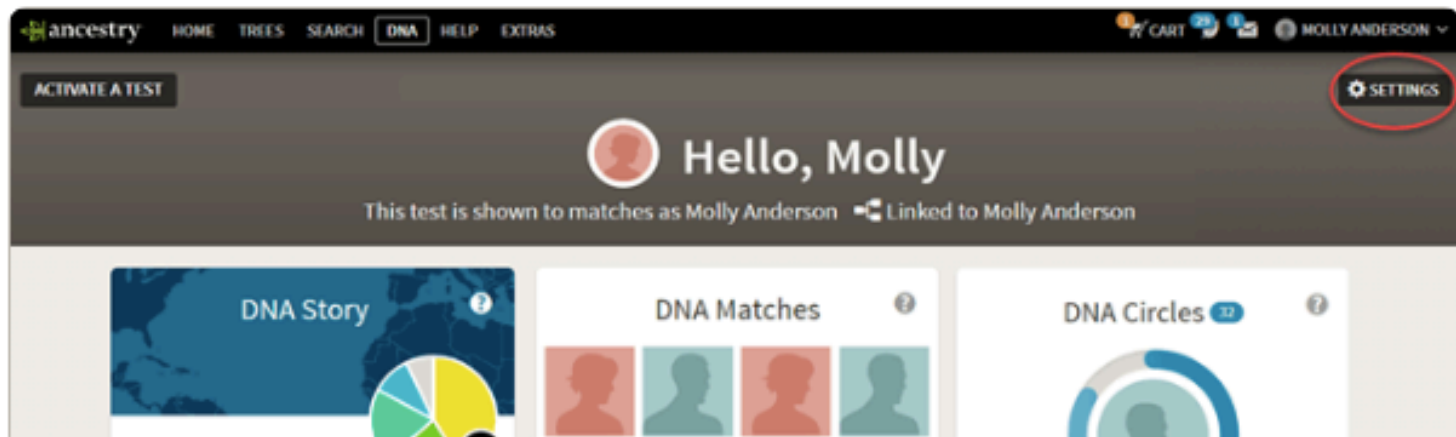
1 Log in to your Ancestry account.

2 Click the **DNA** tab and select **Your DNA Results Summary**.

STEP


3 Click **SETTINGS** on the right side of the page.

6 In the email and click **Confirm Data Download**.

7 Click **DOWNLOAD DNA RAW DATA**.

STEP

8 file will be downloaded to your computer.
